General Instructions and Guidelines

1. Age limit: - (i) Professor – upto 55 years, (ii) Librarian – upto 50 years, (iii) Assistant Professor and (iv) Accounts Officer – upto 45 years as on last date of submission of application.
2. Faculty positions are required for both *research and teaching* of Ph.D., LL.M & Post Graduate Diploma Courses in the area of Comparative Jurisprudence, Judicial Process, Comparative Constitutional Law, International Trade Law, Legal Research Methodology & writing skill, Intellectual Property Rights Law, Cyber Law, Criminal Law, Human Rights Law & Corporate Law etc.

3. For faculty and academic positions, API score is to be strictly as per latest UGC guidelines and the applicant must to fill up API score form (Form 2) in the online application system.
4. Online Application Form is available at Institute's website www.ili.ac.in.
5. Candidates interested in applying for more than one post have to apply separately in the online application process paying separate application fee to online mode for each post.
6. Fulfilling minimum eligibility criteria will not entitle a candidate to be considered for appointment and higher eligibility criteria may be fixed in case number of applications are more for a particular post.
7. The Institute reserve the right to short-list applicants in any manner as may be considered appropriate.
8. The Institute may add/relax any of the requirements specified above so as to shortlist the applications depending upon number of the applications received.
