PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

This course is aimed to enable the participants to acquire comprehensive understanding of the concepts of the mediation which need to be used keeping in view the requirements of Section 89 of CPC and other statutory Enactments requiring use of mediation as an effective tool for dispute resolution.

Further it will provide an insight into the alternative dispute resolution mechanism which is a systematic process that addresses disputes that arise between two or more parties in a legal relationship, with a flavour of practical perspective wherever needed.

1. Providing the basic concepts of AIM negotiation and communication required for conducting and participating in a mediation process .
2. Rendering a mechanism for the parties to assess strengths and weakness of their cases.
3. Teaching a systematic framework for understanding the concept of mediation.
4. Explaining the role of mediator, role of the parties and role of lawyers in mediation.
