“SITUATING JUSTICE IN ARMED CONFLICT:
CAN THERE BE JUST WARS?”

Armed conflicts raise a multitude of legal-political questions ranging from the reasons of its inception (is it a ‘just war’?) to the means and methods of the conduct of hostilities (whom to target, what amount of force can be used, etc.) and the aftermath (the socio-political and economic instability, the rights of displaced people and refugees, sanctions for violations and abuses committed, etc.). Considering the complexities surrounding armed conflicts, the Indian Law Institute is organizing a 3-Day Conference to interrogate the notion of justice in armed conflicts, titled “SITUATING JUSTICE IN ARMED CONFLICT: CAN THERE BE JUST WARS?”. We hope that the involvement of different stakeholders from the academia, the administration, the military, and judiciary could help us explore these issues (and more which would come up during the engagement) to situate whether justice could possibly exist in an armed conflict – and if yes, how?
