2. The Candidates have to carry original documents alongwith one set of self attested copies of the following documents and visit **Academic Section (Room No. 1) at Indian Law Institute, New Delhi**.
 - Marksheets & Certificates (10th, 12th and Graduation Degree)
 - Marksheets and Certificates of LL.B.
 - Copy of OBC Certificate & Migration Certificate
 - Passport size photograph
 - Vaccination certificate duly downloaded from www.cowin.gov.in platform.
 - Declaration and undertaking format duly filled in as provided with this SOP.
3. Candidates have to make sure that they are eligible for admission to the Course. Any candidate found ineligible at any point of time during study will be summarily rejected. The admission shall stand cancelled if student is unable to produce the original document.
4. Documents/ certificates shall have to be produced in *original* for verification.
5. The admission will only be confirmed after physical verification of documents and successful payment of prescribed fee (Online mode).
6. **The candidates appearing for the minimum eligibility examinations are required to submit their certificate positively on or before September 15, 2022. In case of failure of submission of required certificate(s) for fulfilling eligibility criteria, the admission will be cancelled.**
